I was in the Pygmy village of Bobele in Central African Republic for the exciting opening of the school which will train Pygmies to reach other Pygmies for Christ.

The students in the missionary training school in Bangui joined the Pygmy students for this opening week. One day Brother Anatole Banga had two women come to me, to show me their babies. One was a Pygmy woman who had been barren for 20 years, and the other was a student at the Bangui training school. On past trips I had prayed for both of them to be able to conceive, and God gave them the desires of their hearts!

In **Bangui**, Anatole planned a free dinner as an outreach to the unchurched people of the city. **Twenty people responded to the invitation to receive Christ as their Saviour.** Praise God!!!

In **Uganda** I was privileged to stay at Harvest Ministry's **Osanidde Village**. A number of you have been involved in the building of this orphanage, financing all or part of four houses and the chapel, as well as providing ongoing support for the girls of Siloam House. **The children and staff want me to tell you, “Thank you VERY much!!”**



As Marilyn and I were praying over this trip, the Lord led us to include a **crusade in an area that had never had a crusade before.** He made it possible for us to work with Brother Drake Kanaabo to hold a crusade in the village of **Bugera, Uganda.** We praise God that **50 people made decisions for Christ, including the village chief's wife and a man who had been a murderer.** Both have been traveling about the island sharing what God has done for them!
